

HAYS COUNTY 4-H LIVESTOCK AMBASSADOR AGREEMENT

This Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the undersigned 4-H member ("Ambassador") and Hays County 4-H ("Organization"). This Agreement outlines the terms and conditions under which the Ambassador agrees to serve as an Hays County 4-H Livestock Ambassador.

1. Ambassador's Commitment:

The Ambassador agrees to actively participate in a minimum of 70% of livestock events organized by the Organization. These events include, but are not limited to, validations, horse shows, and livestock workshops. The Ambassador must be a currently enrolled 4-H member in good standing.

2. Species of Expertise:

The Ambassador will choose a specific species (e.g., cattle, poultry, sheep) in which they possess knowledge and experience. The Ambassador commits to sharing their expertise with fellow members and participants during events.

3. General Livestock Assistance:

While the Ambassador may specialize in a particular species, they are expected to provide assistance and support in all livestock-related activities organized by the Organization.

4. Attendance and Punctuality:

The Ambassador agrees to attend all scheduled livestock events promptly. In the event of unavoidable circumstances preventing attendance, the Ambassador shall notify the Organization in advance.

5. Educational Outreach:

The Ambassador agrees to actively engage in educational outreach activities, sharing information about agriculture and livestock with the community. This may include presentations, demonstrations, or other forms of educational content.

6. Leadership Record Book:

The Ambassador further agrees to submit a record book summarizing their leadership experience at the county level. This record book will provide insights into the Ambassador's contributions, achievements, and growth throughout the duration of their service.

7. Conduct and Leadership:

The Ambassador shall conduct themselves in a manner befitting a youth leader, exhibiting good sportsmanship, respect for others, and promoting a positive and inclusive environment within the 4-H community. Violations of the 4-H Code of Conduct or failure to meet the agreed requirements will be grounds for termination.

8. Duration of Agreement:

This Agreement shall be effective from September 1, 2024 and shall remain in effect until August 31, 2025. Either party may terminate this Agreement with written notice in case of a breach of terms or for any other reasonable cause.

9. Termination:

In the event of termination, the Ambassador agrees to return any provided materials, resources, or equipment belonging to the Organization.

10. Consent and Acknowledgment:
